SPECIAL NOTICE

Hazing is not restricted to associate members.

Delta Chi Law defines hazing as:

“...any action or situation created whether on or off fraternity of campus premises, which produces mental or physical discomfort, embarrassment, harassment, anxiety or ridicule, no matter how good the intent or end result.”

Whether the individual affected is an associate member or an initiated member is irrelevant. There are a variety of situations that could involve the hazing of an initiated member. In response to or “in honor of” an initiated member getting lavaliered, pinned or engaged, some chapters have a favored “treatment.” “Flagpoling,” body painting and throwing the member in the shower are examples of such treatment. Each of these are viewed as hazing by Delta Chi. A couple of years ago an individual was dropped as he was being carried to the shower and suffered a torn shoulder muscle and a concussion when his head hit a water fountain. Embarrassing public displays clearly fit the definition of hazing. There are other activities that are also hazing.

If your chapter participates in such activities CEASE AND DESIST now or you will face potential disciplinary action.
